| Pressure washing with a Hotsy or Landa washer | Slips<br>Trips<br>Falls<br>Lacerations<br>Struck-by<br>electrocution | <ul> <li>Don booties and place wet floor signs in direct area before operating a pressure washer.</li> <li>Use a safety vest when there is risk of vehicular traffic in the area.</li> <li>Safety glasses shall be worn to prevent particles from flying up and coming in contact with eyes.</li> <li>Be familiar with how to turn off machine and bleed pressure out before operating the equipment.</li> <li>Make sure electrical connections are grounded using a 3-prong outlet.</li> <li>Keep water spray away from electric wiring or electric shock may result.</li> <li>Always hold the spray gun with both hands to prevent kick back.</li> <li>Firmly grip spray gun before starting to prevent gun from whipping and causing bodily harm.</li> <li>Never spray washer towards persons or vehicles as it can cause bodily harm.</li> <li>Do not attempt to overreach or stand on an unstable footing while operating equipment.</li> <li>Never leave equipment unattended.</li> </ul> |
