### **Subject: Unsafe Working with an Excavator**

#### What is the danger / risk?

A recent near miss highlighted that a supervisor and operative were using a bucket as an access platform. This incident had the potential for serious injury / fatality to occur. This behaviour is not acceptable at any time.

#### **Incident Information**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> July a supervisor and banksman were standing in the bucket of the 8 tonne excavator whilst being lifted approx. 1.5m. No one was injured. Team have been suspended

Many accidents have occurred within the construction industry whilst performing similar tasks. It is a legal requirement within the Health and Safety law that equipment is fit for purpose, i.e. buckets are not access platforms.

## **Action Required**

The following action must be carried out on all projects:

- All personnel are to understand their roles and responsibilities under section 2 of the Health and Safety at Work Act.
- All activities are to properly planned, appropriately supervised and carried out in a safe manner
- Planning must include the selection of appropriate work equipment and planning for any emergencies or any rescue
- All works must have a suitable and sufficient risk assessment
- All personnel are to report any activity or defect that they know is to endanger the safety of themselves or that or any other person
